- ❑ Dr. Mitsutaku MAKINO is a Professor of Atmosphere and Ocean Research Institute (AORI), University of Tokyo, specialized in fisheries and ocean policy science. He is also serving as the President of Ocean Policy Research Institute of Sasakawa Peace Foundation (OPRI-SPF).
- ❑ He got his Undergraduate Degree and Master Degree in Kyoto University, another Master Degree in University of Cambridge, and Ph.D at Kyoto University in 2003.
- ❑ He served as a policy researcher at Japan Fisheries Research and Education Agency for 15 years and worked closely with local, national and international governments for policy development before moving to University of Tokyo in 2019. He also took the role of President of OPRI-SPF from 2025.
- ❑ He is the Chair of Human Dimension Committee of North Pacific Marine Science Organization (PICES), Japan Delegate to IOC-UNESCO, and contributing many other international marine science activities.
