The PICES Special Publication on Marine Ecosystems of the North Pacific is the first attempt to summarize the climate, oceanography, chemistry and biology of this important region.

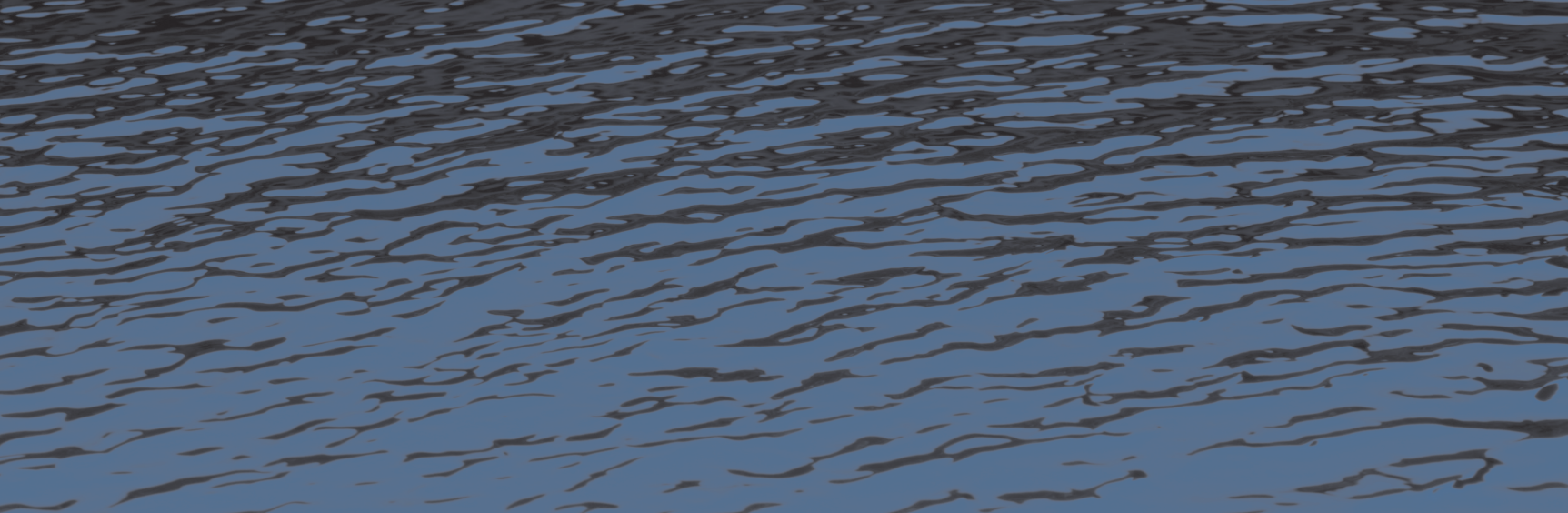


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Caveat

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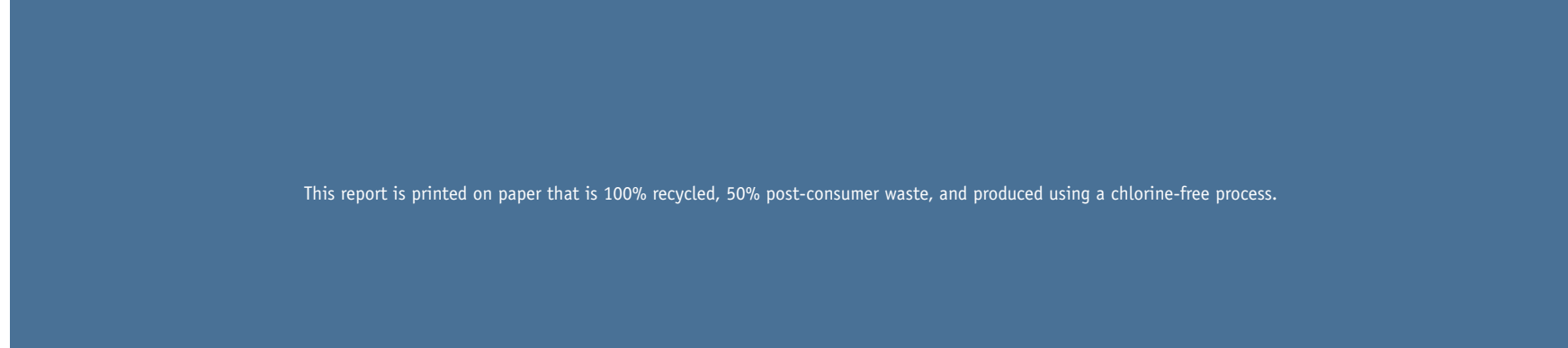
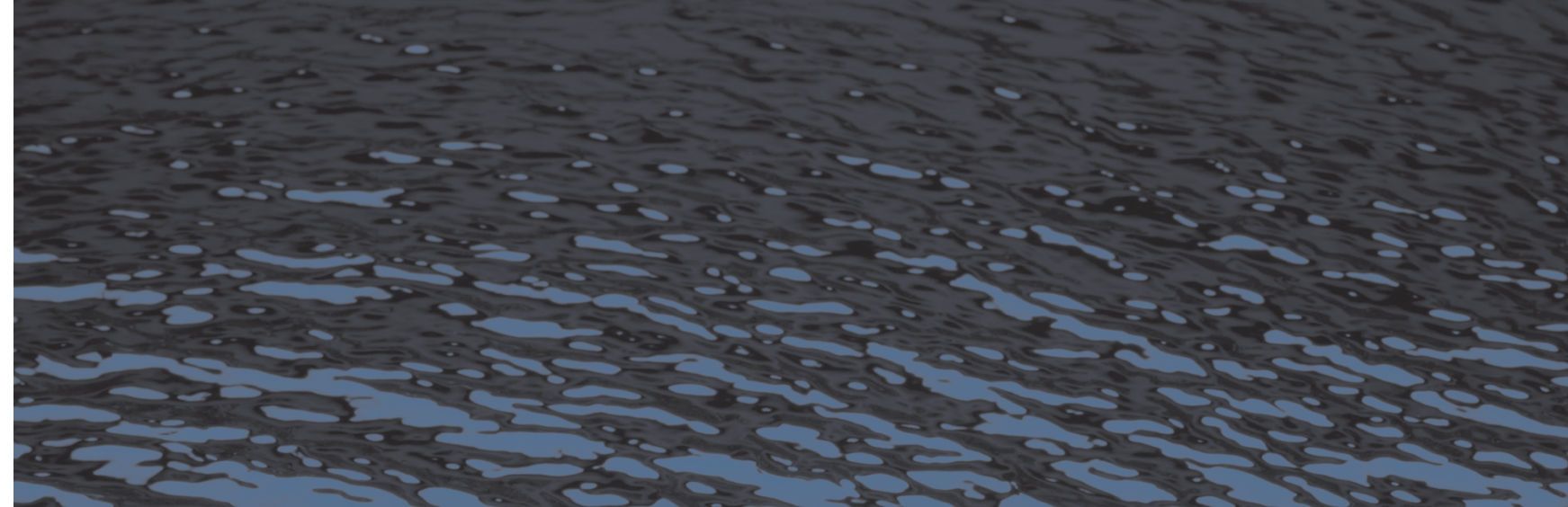
